

## Sherwood Township Meeting June 06, 2023

Meeting called to order by Supervisor Robbins at 7:30 pm.  
Board members present, Brubaker, Whitcomb, Brott, and Haack.  
The Pledge to the Flag of the United States of America lead by Robbins.

Minutes from May meeting read. Motion to approve minutes by Robbins, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Haack. Voted and passed.

### New business;

Township assessor, Marcia Bail explained the 2023 tax resolution and that it is the same as last year, .8675. Request from the county was signed and will be sent.

Bail thanked the board for allowing the Village of Sherwood to piggyback on to the township tax program. Supervisor Robbins explained the agreement with the village.

### Old Business;

Dust control was contacted by Robbins and he was informed that the county road commission will not be grading the gravel roads again so dust control will begin as soon as Union Township is done which will be the first of next week. Dust control said they will come back and do 2<sup>nd</sup> application if necessary.

Union City manager Chris Mathis has contacted Robbins about the Dam Celebration that is scheduled for July 22, 2023 and confirmed that the village does have insurance to cover the celebration. Also the Sherwood fire department has been contacted and will be on sight.

### Fire Department Report;

Fire Chief Jeff Smurr reported there were 7 fire calls for the month of May. One Mutual Aid to Bronson Township, two personal injury accidents, one explosion reported, one power line down, one burning complaint, and one citizen assist. Two trainings took place.

Smurr reported that he is working on a grant with Union City fire department on the purchase of new grass fire bunkers that are lighter for this purpose. The grant could be a 50/50 match for both departments. This would be approximately \$13,000 of equipment.

Planning Commission Report;

Planning commission chair Don Esch said there was nothing to report.

Treasurers Report;

Treasurer Dale Marie Brubaker reported the general fund balance at the end of May was \$295,357.00. Summer and winter tax payments have been received. \$26,595.00 goes to the Lake Association fund.

Property on Chipawa Circle has been sold and the back taxes have been paid to the county.

Clerk Report;

Clerk Marjorie Whitcomb reported that the July Meeting would fall on July 4. After discussion it was decided the July meeting will be canceled and the next township meeting will be August 1, 2023.

Whitcomb reported that the special school election for Colon schools will be August 8 and that it will be done in our township for Colon School tax payers.

Because Parks tree service is no longer in business township is looking for a different tree service to remove trees in 2 cemeteries.

Have received bid to replace damaged gas tank and fence and have contacted insurance company also have gotten a police report. Have received a price bid for lighting on fuel tank area.

Was suggested to contact Lucus Kronkite to install the drop box for the required voting process.

Supervisor Report;

Supervisor Aaron Robbins thought all of his reports were covered in earlier discussion.

Motion to pay bills by Robbins. 2<sup>nd</sup> Haack. Voted and passed.

Motion to adjourn meeting by Robbins. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Brott. Voted and passed.
