Special Meeting
March 16, 2024

Supervisor Aaron Robbins called the special meeting to order at 8:34 am. Board members present; Dale Marie Brubaker, Marjorie Whitcomb, and Jeff Brott. Also in attendance, Fire Chief Jeff Smurr.

The budget adjustments were discussed, Whitcomb had done figures on pay raises and presented them to the board. Burbaker made a motion to raise the board wages 5% and firefighters hourly wage to \$17.30. Training's for firefighters will stay at \$26.50 per meeting. Robbins 2nd. Voted and passed.

Whitcomb made a motion to increase the mileage rate to \$.67 per mile as the state rate. 2nd by Brott. Voted and passed.

Fire Chief Smurr presented the board with a price for a new fire rig truck that is for sale at Hemel's Chevrolet in Colon. The price is \$26,175.00. The milage on the 2014 one ton truck is approximately 25,000 miles. The board members viewed pictures of the truck and agree with Smurr that it is an exceptional truck. Smurr reminded the board that the truck will need a new slide in poly water tank and some updates to make it ready.

Robbins made a motion to purchase the said truck for \$26,175.00. 2nd by Brott. Voted and passed.

Whitcomb asked the boards permission to allow the Sherwood Garden Club to have a chair yoga class in the township building on March 28th. Board gave their approval.

Motion to adjourn the meeting by Robbins. 2nd Brott. Voted and passed. Meeting adjourned at 9:12am.
